### **Comint Support Instruction**

### AHQ (DMI) Instruction No. 1/66

On 17 June 1966<sup>1</sup>, AHQ (DMI) Instruction No. 1/66 *Comint Support For 1 ATF Vietnam*<sup>2</sup> was issued by the then Director of Military Intelligence, Colonel "Sandy" Pearson<sup>3</sup>:




Figure 1: Comint Support Instruction





#### Introduction

 Approval has been given for the employment of the AMP personnel, in conjunction with the US ASA organization, in Communication Intelligence (Comint) operations in South Vietnan in direct support of 1 ATF.

### Ains of this Instruction

 The sim of this instruction is to formally implement the proposals that have been agreed by the Australian and United States national authorities.

### General Cutline

- 3. a. <u>Purpose of Operation</u> is for the AMF to establish a comint cell at 1 ATF to receive end product material from US ASA resources. In addition AMF personnel will conduct communications intercept, processing and reporting activities as agreed by US ASA, to meet the requirements of the Commender t-Aust-Task Force.
  - b. Provision of Resources The AMF will provide 15 personnel from Australia i.e., Detachment 547 Signal Troop, 7 Signal Regiment. One additional linguist will be made available from the HQ AFV pool of linguists to support this detachment. The detachment will be known as the AMF Direct Support Unit (DSU) of 1 ATF in keeping with US terminology for similar US ASA units.

### Control of AMP DGU

### 4. Command and Control

The AMF DSU will be under the command and control of the Commander 1 ATF.

### 5. Operational Control

The ANF DSU will be under the operational control of US ASA organisation for operational tasking instructions and technical support.

### 6. National Control

As all matters effecting Signal intelligence are controlled at the national level in Australia and USA, any changes in role of the AMF DSU must be referred to ASQ (DMI) for discussion between the Mational Authorities.

### Operational Deployment

The actual deployment of AMP personnel in theatre will be subject to consultation with the responsible US ASA authority. The agreed deployment must at all times be in such a manner to ensure maximum comint support for 1 ATF.

### Communications

- 8. Exclusive comint communications between the AMP DSU and the appropriate US ASA organisation will be provided by the US ASA unit supporting 2 FFV. These communications charmels will be used for the passage of all comint material i.e., policy, steerage instructions, raw materials and end product material between the AMF DSU, US Authorities and AHQ (INI) Camberra.
- ..dministrative traffic will be passed on normal AMF channels provided from within 1 ATF resources.

10. The following AFF personnel will be provided for this operations

### Provision of Technical Stores and Equipment

- The AMF will be responsible for the provision of the technical stores, vehicles and equipment required for the AMF DSU from Australia.
- 12. Where specialist stores are not available from Australia, arrangements will be made on the National level for the US ...S. organisation to provide these stores in theatre.

### Tinings-

13. The AMF DSU will arrive in Vietnem by 14 Jun 66. A period of three weeks training will be required after arrival to ensure the personnel are familiar with US ASA methods of operation. The target date for the AMF DSU operations at 1 ATF is 1 Jul 66.

### Terms of Reference

14. The terms of reference for the Officer Commanding the AMF DSU are attached as Annex A to this instruction.

### Personal Security

- Indoctrinated personnel only will be employed in or with the AMF DSU.
- 16. All AMF DSU personnel will be briefed on a cover story to cover the operations of the DSU. This cover story will be based on Radio Research which is the similar cover story applied to US ASA operations in Vietnem.
- 17. The LMF DSU will follow security instructions issued for US LSA organisations when using or handling items of equipment of US origin.

### Physical Security

- 18. The following minimum security presentions will be taken:
  - a. A wire security fence will be erected around the operational area of the DSU.
  - b. Only indoctrinated personnel will be allowed within the ESU compound.
  - o. Security containers will be provided for all sensitive material. Such material when not in use will be stored in these containers.
  - d. All waste naterial will be destroyed by fire.
  - e. An armed guard will be on duty within the DSU compound 24 hours daily.

19. Datailed security instructions are contained in the terms of reference for the GC .MF ISU attached as Annex A.

### Hazardous Operations

20. We person with a detailed comint knowledge will be used on hazardous operations where his capture or interrogation could be a substantial risk to the security of comint.

### Administration

### Responsibility for Administration

a. The AMP DSU is NOT a self contained unit and therefore must be administered by a unit within 1 ATF.
